**'Songs of Sir Paul' tribute concert to benefit the Music Moves Mountains Foundation

Special guests include CITRUS (another young, talented band aged 12-15 years from Band Aid School of Music), Jonathan Fox, Larry Seaman, Steve McCarthy, and more.
